2. You may skate any event you are eligible for. There are no restrictions.
3. Please be ready to skate one hour ahead of your event's schedule.

Name, Sex, and Age as of Jan 1, 2005, Amateur Card number, Partner's name. If it is listed as a combined event already on the event list, please list the event that skater will skate at this year's regional championships.
