**Creative Solo** Event will be skated as follows:

**Creative Solo will be broken down in to 2 events:**

12 and Under will be one event(Quads and Inlines will compete together).

13 and Over will be the other age group(Quads and Inlines will compete together).

## **Pairs**

Pairs events will be skated as one event. If there enough teams to warrant break the event up, I will.

1. All skaters must hold a current 2009-10 USA Roller Sports Amateur Card or purchase a single event card for this meet only.
2. You may skate any event you are eligible for. There are no restrictions.
3. Please be ready to skate one hour ahead of your event's schedule.

**Name, Sex, and Age as of Jan 1, 2010, Amateur Card number, Partner's name.**

**If it is listed as a combined event already on the event list, please list the event that skater will skate at this year's regional championships.**
