DIRECTIONS FROM THE AIRPORT: Follow directions to Pittsburgh out of airport to RT 279 East. Take I-79 South to Washington, PA. Take I-70 East to Donora Exit # 43B Follow further directions below.

DIRECTIONS FROM I-70 EAST: Exit # 43B DONORA. Follow further directions below.

DIRECTIONS FROM I 70 WEST: Exit # 43 DONORA. Follow further directions below.

DIRECTIONS FROM RT 51 NORTH: Take Rt 51 South to Rt 136. Exit to the right. Turn right at stop and continue down a long winding hill to the river road (Rt 906) Turn left onto Rt 906 South. Travel 1.3 mile to traffic light. Turn right at light and cross bridge. Turn left off bridge and come to the second traffic light (6th Street) Turn left at light and cross RR Tracks. Valley Skating Center is on the right.

DIRECTIONS FROM RT 51 NORTH TO I-70 West. Exit at # 43-B Donora. Follow further directions below.

FURTHER DIRECTIONS AFTER EXITING I-70

Turn right off exit and go through RR underpass. Follow four land road to the left. You will go up a grade and down a long hill, and then cross a bridge. Turn RIGHT off the bridge. You will see a Blue Sign that says Donora Industrial Park. Turn RIGHT at the sign. You will then go down a grade and down a long straight stretch to a stop sign.. Turn LEFT at the stop and LEFT into the Valley Skating Center Parking Lot.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR EVENTS

- All USARS Events will be skated.. You may skate only events for which you are eligible under USARS Rules.
- Since this is not a qualifying meet, JR WC skaters will be allowed to challenge up. If they do not challenge up, they may skate their regular “A” event. There will be **no other challenge up allowed.**
- Skaters may skate C & B or B & A, but may not skate C & A events.
- All **Figure, Singles, & Pairs** events will use the USARS rules for eliminations and final events. All dance events with 8 or less will become a final event. Skating the Elim dances. Dance events with 22 or more skaters will skate an 8 skater final.
- There will be no cross over between ESQUIRE A, MASTERS A, VETERANS A You may skate only one division.
- Solo dance will follow the guidelines established by USARS.
- USARS dress rules will be observed for ALL events.
